#### **Biographical Note**

Henry Ward Beecher (1813-1887), son of Lyman Beecher, was an American clergyman born in Litchfield, Connecticut, in 1813. He was known as a powerful and convincing speaker who commanded wide influence throughout the country. Along with his sister, Harriet Beecher

Stowe, he was an abolitionist and a supporter of women suffrage. He served the Plymouth Congregational Church in Brooklyn, New York, from 1847 until his death in 1887.
