Benjamin F. Akin, physician and graduate of the Georgia College of Eclectic Medicine and Surgery (1899), married Hattie T. Barron, physician and graduate of the Women's Medical

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College of Georgia (1893), sometime after 1893. They practiced medicine in Jackson and Jenkinsburg, Georgia, until circa 1940.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of materials related to Benjamin Aikin from 1888-1940. The papers include correspondence, ledgers, printed materials, diplomas, clippings, photographs, miscellany, and books related to patients of Drs. Akin, medicines, or the practice of medicine.
