Scope and Content Note

The Anarchist collection is an artificial collection of primarily printed material documenting anarchist and communist groups including *Win*, *Liberation*, *The Catholic Worker*, *Peace News*, *Libertaire*, and *The Berkeley Barb* as well as others. The collection includes copies of serials, newspapers, fliers, and booklets from the 1940s through the 1970s. Also included artwork, *The Black Hole*, 2012, as well as research files compiled by original owners and consisting of printed materials with a small amount of writings and three phonographs.
