Collection Description

Biographical Note

Horace Mann Bond (1904-1972) was born in Nashville, Tennessee, to James Bond and Jane Alice (Browne) Bond. His parents were both children of former slaves. Jane Bond, a graduate of Oberlin College, was a teacher, and James Bond, also a graduate of Oberlin, worked as a Congregationalist minister, often in churches attached to historically black colleges in the south. Horace Mann Bond attended Lincoln University from 1919-1923, beginning work on his Ph.D. at the University of Chicago in 1924. From 1924-1939, while also working to complete his dissertation, *Social and Economic Influences on the Public School Education of Negroes in Alabama, 1865-1930*, Bond taught at colleges throughout the south, including Langston University (Langston, Oklahoma), Fisk University (Nashville, Tennessee), and Dillard University (New Orleans, Louisiana). In 1939, Bond became president of Fort Valley Normal and Industrial School in Fort Valley, Georgia, overseeing the institution's transition from a two-year junior college to a four-year college. In 1945, Bond accepted the presidency of Lincoln University (Pennsylvania), a position he held for 12 years before taking the position of Dean of the School of Education at Atlanta University. He retired from Atlanta University in 1971.

In 1929, Horace Mann Bond married Julia Agnes Washington (1908-2007). Julia's mother, Daisy Agnes Turner Washington, was a teacher, and her father, George Elihu Washington, was the principal of Pearl High School in Nashville, Tennessee. Julia was a graduate of Pearl High School, as well as Fisk University, where she met Horace. In 1964, Julia received a master's degree from the Atlanta University School of Library Service and worked both at Atlanta University's Trevor Arnett Library and the Atlanta University Center Robert W. Woodruff Library. She also served on numerous library boards and friends groups in Atlanta. The couple had three children: lawyer Jane (Bond) Moore, civil rights activist and politician Julian Bond, and politician and media personality James Bond.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the family papers of Horace Mann Bond and Julia W. Bond from 1866-2009. The papers include correspondence, Horace Mann Bond's personal and professional papers; Julia W. Bond's personal and professional papers; papers of other family members; printed material; photographs; audiovisual material; and collections created by the family including stamps and autographs. Correspondence includes letters between Julia and Horace Mann Bond from the 1930s as well as correspondence between Julia Bond and her parents and other family members.

Horace Mann Bond's papers include diaries, financial records, and membership cards. His papers also include professional correspondence that contains letters between Bond and colleagues such as W.E.B. Du Bois, W.C. Handy, Langston Hughes, Richard Nixon, Arthur Schomburg, Hale Woodruff, Kwame Nkrumah and Rufus Clement. There are teaching and university files documenting his courses and administrative responsibilities at Fort Valley State College, Lincoln University, and Atlanta University as well as research and writings, including drafts of his unpublished autobiography and a significant portion of research material from his project, "A Study of the Factors Involved in the Identification and Encouragement of Unusual Academic Talent among Underprivileged Populations".

Julia W. Bond's papers include diaries, financial and legal records, property records, and files relating to her education. They also contain records documenting her work as a librarian; materials relating to the death and estate of Horace Mann Bond; writings by Julia W. Bond; and writings by others. Materials relating to the death and estate of Horace Mann Bond include files relating to the placement of his papers at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst as well as files documenting the microfilming and use of those papers by researchers. Also present are files relating to the posthumous publication of two works: *Education for Freedom: A History of Lincoln University, Pennsylvania* (1976) and *The Star Creek Papers* (1997), which Julia Bond also co-authored. Writings by Julia Bond include mostly short biographical pieces, and writings by others include articles, essays, and poems sent to Julia, mostly about Horace Mann Bond.

Other family members' papers primarily include materials relating to the three Bond children, their education and early careers. Printed material includes material written by the Bond family, primarily by Horace Mann and Julian Bond; printed material about the Bond family; and other printed material which includes material documenting educational issues, civil rights and African American history, and material written by or about the extended Bond and Washington families.

Photographs include portraits and snapshots of the nuclear Bond family, as well as numerous photos of Horace Mann Bond's teaching career, especially his work with the Julius Rosenwald

Fund and his trips to Africa. Audiovisual material is limited but includes the film "An African Comes Home", which is a twelve-minute documentary of Horace Mann Bond's 1949 trip to Nigeria. Family collections include autograph and stamp collections gathered by various members of the Bond family.

Throughout the collection, "Bond family" when used in a series or subseries title refers specifically to Horace Mann Bond, Julia W. Bond and their children, Jane, Julian and James.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of correspondence written by and to the Bond family from 1866-2007. The series is divided into three subseries: family correspondence, general correspondence, and other correspondence. Family correspondence contains letters between Horace Mann Bond; Julia W. Bond; and their children, Jane, Julian and James. General correspondence contains letters between the Bond family and entities outside their immediate family, including extended family, friends and other associates, and some professional correspondence of Julia W. Bond. Other correspondence is between individuals outside the immediate Bond family, such as letters between Julia's siblings, Joe Washington Jones, Henry Alvin Washington, Marguerite Washington, and their mother, Daisy Washington Brumfield.

For Horace Mann Bond's professional correspondence, see Subseries 2.2: Professional correspondence. For additional personal correspondence between the adult Bond children and entities outside the immediate Bond family, see Series 4: Other family members' papers.

Scope and Content Note

The subseries contains correspondence between Horace Mann Bond; Julia W. Bond; and their children, Jane, Julian and James from 1928-2004. The correspondence documents the courtship and early marriage of Horace and Julia and also includes letters between Horace and Julia and their children while the latter attended boarding schools and colleges. Correspondence from the 1950s features letters from Horace to the family during his visits to Africa. There is also significant communication from Julian and Jane to their mother later in their lives.

Scope and Content Note

The subseries consists of correspondence to and from Horace Mann Bond and Julia W. Bond from entities outside the nuclear Bond family, as well as a small amount of childhood correspondence between each of the Bond children and outside entities. The correspondence includes letters between Horace and his parents, James Bond and Jane (Browne) Bond as well as letters between Julia W. Bond and her mother, Daisy Washington Brumfield. Correspondence between Julia and her mother and grandmother, Callie ("Baby") Browne, and from Julia's brother, Dr. Henry Alvin Washington, features prominently in the subseries. There is also substantial correspondence between Horace and his brothers, James Maxwell ("Max") Bond, Sr., who worked for foreign consulates in Haiti and Africa and appears to have collaborated on a few projects with Horace, and Gilbert ("Gil") Dodson Bond, Sr. Other letters of note include personal messages from Richard Nixon and blues musician W.C. Handy. Also included in the subseries are letters to Julia W. Bond from her grandchildren, Phyllis Bond, Horace Mann ("Manny") Bond, II, Michael Bond, Julia Louise Bond ("Cookie"), Jeffrey Bond, Grace Moore, Constance Moore, and Kojo Moore.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of the papers of Horace Mann Bond from 1928-1972 and includes personal papers; professional correspondence; teaching and university files; and research and writings. Personal papers include diaries, financial documents, and genealogical research on the Bond family. Professional correspondence documents Bond's academic work, primarily in his capacity as President of Lincoln University and as Dean of the School of Education at Atlanta University. Correspondents include W.E.B. Du Bois, Rufus Clement, W.C. Handy, Langston Hughes, Richard Nixon, Arthur Schomburg, and Hale Woodruff, as well as numerous scholars and African dignitaries such as Kwame Nkrumah.

Teaching and university files consist of material relating to Horace Mann Bond's academic and teaching career. The subseries predominantly documents Bond's career as Dean of the School of Education at Atlanta University from 1958-1972 and includes administrative documents such as department meeting agendas; accreditation plans and reports; and teaching files for Bond's classes, particularly "Foundations of Education." There is a small amount of material present documenting Bond's tenure with Fort Valley State College and Lincoln University.

Research and writings include Bond's research files on high school and collegiate education, particularly in Southern states as well as intelligence and standardized testing. The subseries also contains significant information relating to Bond's major research project, *A Study of the Factors Involved in the Identification and Encouragement of Unusual Academic Talent among Underprivileged Populations*, designated by its government identification number "Project 458." There are questionnaires regarding subjects' educational genealogy, as well as charts, created by Bond, to tabulate the data gathered in the questionnaires. The subseries also contains drafts of Bond's writings, including his unpublished autobiography; his history of Lincoln University *God be Glorified by Africa: The History and Sociology of Lincoln University* (published posthumously as *Education for Freedom: A History of Lincoln University*); and multiple articles, speeches, and poems. Research and writings also contain works by other writers and scholars, including Langston Hughes, Kwame Nkrumah, and Booker T. Washington. The work by Washington was likely part of Horace Mann Bond's book or autograph collection.

Material relating to the Bond family genealogy, compiled by Horace Mann Bond, includes family trees, research material, personal questionnaires completed by various family members, and narratives written by both Horace Mann Bond and Julia W. Bond. Also present are files relating to Roger Williams and his book *The Bonds: An American Family* which document both Williams' efforts to publish the book and the Bond family's concerns about the project.

The subseries includes correspondence from Horace Mann Bond in his capacity as President of Lincoln University, involving administrative and faculty decisions, and in his capacity as Dean of Atlanta University's School of Education, primarily communicating with Atlanta University President Rufus Clement. The subseries also contains letters between Bond and various staff of the Julius Rosenwald Fund.

There are a small number of files from Dillard University (New Orleans, Louisiana), Fort Valley State College (Fort Valley, Georgia) and Lincoln University (Pennsylvania); however the records predominantly document Bond's career as Dean of the School of Education at Atlanta University from 1958-1972. Files contain administrative documents such as University Senate meeting minutes; department meeting agendas and minutes; accreditation plans and reports; and other planning documents. There are also files containing syllabi, assignments, admission cards and other documents relating to courses that Bond taught. Chief among them is the course "Foundations of Education," in which the major assignment each semester was a family tree that either documented the student's educational ancestry or situated the family's history inside a larger historical timeline. Materials for this course include exams, as well as the reports and family trees created by students from 1963-1970.

The subseries consists of Horace Mann Bond's academic research and writings from 1934-1966. Research topics include public high school and collegiate education, particularly in Southern states, as well as intelligence and standardized testing. The subseries also includes information relating to Horace Mann Bond's research project, *A Study of the Factors Involved in the Identification and Encouragement of Unusual Academic Talent among Underprivileged Populations*, designated by its government identification number "Project 458." This project traced the genealogies of over five hundred African American doctorate holders through a series of questionnaires which identified the occupation, location, and education level of each subject's extended family. The subseries includes these questionnaires and the data they produced, which can be found in the project's official report and in a number of charts and lists compiled by Horace Mann Bond. The subseries also contains correspondence relating to the project, as well as profiles of prominent African American families.

Writings by Bond primarily include typescripts of Horace Mann Bond's articles and speeches as well as drafts of his unpublished autobiography. The drafts are undated and original order is unclear so drafts have been artificially numbered to indicate different versions of the work. Also included are notes for the publication *Star Creek Papers*, co-authored by Julia W. Bond and published posthumously (See Series 3: Julia W. Bond papers for additional material). Writings also contain drafts of Horace Mann Bond's history of Lincoln University *God be Glorified by Africa: The History and Sociology of Lincoln University* (published posthumously as *Education for Freedom: A History of Lincoln University*). Also present are numerous writings by others, including works by Kwame Nkrumah, Langston Hughes, and Booker T. Washington.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of the papers of Julia W. Bond from 1921-2007 and includes personal papers; papers relating to the death and estate of Horace Mann Bond; professional papers; writings by Julia Bond; and writings by others. Personal papers contain diaries; financial and legal records, property records, and files relating to Julia Bond's education from high school in Nashville, Tennessee through her graduate studies at the Atlanta University School of Library and Information Studies. Personal papers also include files relating to community organizations and boards of which Bond was part, such as the Atlanta Neighborhood Housing Services Board of Directors and the Chautauqua Circle Club.

Materials relating to the death and estate of Horace Mann Bond include files relating to the placement of his papers at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst as well as files documenting the microfilming and use of those papers by researchers. Also present are files relating to the posthumous publication of two works: *Education for Freedom: A History of Lincoln University, Pennsylvania* (1976) and *The Star Creek Papers* (1997), which Julia Bond also co-authored. Professional papers document Julia Bond's career as a teacher and librarian, particularly her time as a librarian working for Atlanta University, Spelman College, and the Atlanta University Center. Writings by Julia Bond include mostly short, biographical pieces, and writings by others include articles, essays, and poems sent to Julia, mostly about Horace Mann Bond.
