The collection consists of the papers of John Wyatt Bonner from 1940-1979. The papers include correspondence, printed material, documents and other research material. Personal and professional correspondence and printed material documents Bonner's military service, education, professional pursuits, and personal interests. Research materials focus on Jones County, Georgia; Telamon Cuyler; and the publishing firm of J.W. Burke Co. of Macon, Georgia.
