Appraisal Note

Acquired by Curator of African American Collections Randall Burkett as part of the Rose Library's holdings in African American history and culture and civil rights movements. During processing, approximately four linear feet of duplicates and extraneous material such as tax forms, personal identification, and medical records, were removed from the collection. Duplicates were shredded and the rest was offered back to Brown. Appraisal decisions were made by Manuscript Archivist Sarah Quigley and Curator of African American Collections Pellom McDaniels, III.

Processing

Arranged and described at the file level by Dayne Alexander, Haylee Harrell, and Sarah Quigley, 2018.

Throughout the collection, arrangement reflects a combination of Elaine Brown's original order and archivist-imposed order. Original folder titles and order of items within files were retained when present. Staff provided titles for untitled files and material that was originally unfolded and imposed the order of files within series to facilitate researcher access.

Collection Description

Biographical Note

Elaine Brown was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in 1943 and raised by her mother, Dorothy Clark. She attended a predominantly white, experimental elementary school where she studied ballet and classical piano. She graduated from the Philadelphia High School for Girls in 1961. She attended Temple University (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) for one semester before moving to Los Angeles, California. Brown joined the Black Panther Party in 1968, eventually serving as the Party's first Chairwoman from 1974-1977. Brown left the Party in 1978 but has continued to work as a community activist. She founded Fields of Flowers in 1996, a non-profit organization dedicated to building a model education center for impoverished children. She is also active in the realm of prison reform and is a co-founder of both Mothers Advocating Juvenile Justice (1998) and the National Alliance for Radical Prison Reform (2003). She has run several campaigns for political office including twice for Oakland, California, City Council (1973 and 1975), once for Mayor of Brunswick, Georgia (2005), and once for the Green Party's

nomination for President of the United States (2007). Brown is also an author, publishing her memoir, *A Taste of Power* (1992) and *The Condemnation of Little B.* (2002), a nonfiction work about thirteen-year-old Michael "Little B." Lewis, who was tried and convicted as an adult for murder in Atlanta, Georgia. She has one daughter Ericka, who was born in 1970.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Elaine Brown from 1977-2010 (bulk 1989-2010) and includes correspondence, writings by Brown, organizational files, campaign records, subject files, and personal papers. Correspondence is both personal and professional and contains letters between Brown and her mother, friends, business associates, publishers, lawyers, and former romantic partner Pierre Elby. Writings by Brown contain drafts of her books *The Condemnation of Little B.* and *A Taste of Power*, as well as other writings, such as articles, essays, and reviews. There is also a significant number of records documenting the murder trial of Michael "Little B." Lewis, the subject of *The Condemnation of Little B.* Organizational files consist of files documenting organizations in which Elaine Brown had a significant leadership role and includes records of the Dr. Huey P. Newton Foundation, Fields of Flowers, the National Association for Radical Prison Reform, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Mothers Advocating Juvenile Justice, and the Brunswick (Georgia) Women's Association for Community Improvement, among others. Campaign records document Elaine Brown's 2005 campaign for Mayor of Brunswick, Georgia, and her 2007 campaign to be the Green Party's candidate for President of the United States. They include campaign contacts, volunteer and mailing lists, fundraising and financial records, and correspondence. Subject files include materials relating to other organizations and projects in which Brown was involved, writings by friends and associates of Brown's, including Barbara Chase-Riboud, and planning files for Brown's speaking engagements. Personal papers contain financial records, photographs, travel documents, calendars and day planners, notes, phone messages, business cards, and legal records from Brown's defamation lawsuit against Kathleen Cleaver in 2008. The collection does not contain records of her work with the Black Panther Party, but there is material in the collection about the history and legacy of the Party.

Correspondence includes speaking invitations, business proposals, readers' letters and Brown's responses, thank you notes, holiday cards, interview questions and responses, and correspondence with publishing companies regarding Brown's writing and business engagements. This series also contains letters between Brown and her mother, friends, business associates, and former partner Pierre Elby, as well as Brown's exchanges with businesses and lawyers regarding her personal legal cases.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of writings by Brown from 1989-2010 and includes drafts of her books *The Condemnation of Little B.* and *A Taste of Power*, as well as other writings, such as articles, essays, and reviews. Both subseries documenting each book contain drafts, notes, research files, outlines, correspondence, and legal records. The subseries for *The Condemnation of Little B.* contains a significant amount of material documenting the murder trial of Michael "Little B." Lewis, who was tried as an adult and convicted of murder at the age of thirteen.

Arrangement Note

Organized into three subseries: (2.1) *The Condemnation of Little B.*, (2.2) *A Taste of Power*, and (2.3) Other writings.

Subseries 2.1***The Condemnation of Little B.*, 1994-2007****Boxes 3 - 10, 42 and OP 1****Scope and Content Note**

The subseries consists of research, notes, chapter outlines, and drafts of Brown's 2002 biography *The Condemnation of Little B.*, detailing the 1997 case of thirteen-year-old Michael "Little B" Lewis, who was tried as an adult and convicted of murder in Atlanta, Georgia. The subseries also contains correspondence between Brown and her publisher, Beacon Press, and her literary agency, Dijkstra, and financial information, such as royalty statements and travel receipts. A significant portion of the subseries is legal records documenting the *State of Georgia v. Michael Lewis*, including briefs, an application for habeas corpus with supporting materials, an amended motion for new trial, witness statements, evidentiary documents about victim Darrell Woods, and police statements. Material relating to the court case also contains correspondence from Lewis to Brown, in which Lewis addresses Brown as "mom," as well as letters between Brown and lawyers discussing Lewis' legal fees. The majority of the correspondence relating to the case documents the Michael Lewis Defense fund, a fund established to help with Lewis' legal fees and to publicize the injustice of Lewis' incarceration.

Subseries 2.2***A Taste of Power*, 1990-2010****Boxes 10 - 14, 40****Scope and Content Note**

The subseries consists of complete and incomplete drafts, edits, proofs, research, legal disputes, and book tour planning documents regarding Brown's 1992 memoir *A Taste of Power*. *A Taste of Power* details Brown's life from her childhood in Philadelphia to her involvement with and leadership of The Black Panther Party. Corrected typescript drafts contain edits by both Brown and her Pantheon Books editor, Linda Healey. Legal disputes document defamation claims made against Brown by Tamara Baltar and Larry Henson, as well as a related lawsuit between Brown and Pantheon Books regarding settlement of the Henson case. This subseries also includes correspondence, options, and agreements regarding potential film and television adaptations of the book, such as the HBO miniseries "The Black Panthers." Brown's correspondence is largely with Suzanne de Passe, executive of the de Passe Entertainment production company.

Processing Note

In this subseries staff have retained Brown's aggregations but were unable to identify the sequence for all of the drafts. Each undated or otherwise unidentified draft was assigned an arbitrary number to differentiate them from each other; these numbers do not reflect the chronological order in which the drafts were created.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of files documenting organizations in which Elaine Brown had a significant leadership role from 1989-2007 and includes records of the Dr. Huey P. Newton Foundation, Fields of Flowers, the National Association for Radical Prison Reform, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Mothers Advocating Juvenile Justice, and the Brunswick (Georgia) Women's Association for Community Improvement, among others. Records of the Dr. Huey P. Newton Foundation, of which Brown was Vice President, document the sale of Newton's papers to Stanford University, collaborative educational projects with the University of New Mexico and Emory University, and ongoing work to promote the legacy of Newton and the Black Panther Party. Files for Fields of Flowers and the National Association for Radical Prison Reform contain administrative records for those organizations, as well as documentation of community projects and research files on similar organizations. Records relating to the Southern Christian Leadership Conference document Brown's attempt to run for a position on the Board of Directors and subsequent lawsuit against the organization for revoking affiliate memberships to prevent representatives of those groups from voting during the National Convention. Files relating to Brown's membership in other organizations, such as Mothers Advocating Juvenile Justice and the Brunswick Women's Association for Community Improvement, document her community activism and involvement in local politics.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of general subject files and files relating to Elaine Brown's speaking engagements from 1979-2010. General subject files document organizations that Brown was involved in, such as the Black Riders Liberation Party, Black Women's Conference, Women's Literary Collective, and Black Women's Think Tank, and projects that Brown worked on, such as the "IMAGINE" radio talk show, Oakland School Project, La Jeunesse Exercise Salon and Day Spa, and her blog on Barack Obama.
