Collection Description

Biographical Note

Roy C. DeLamotte (1918-2010), activist, author, educator and minister, was born in LeCompte, Louisiana. He attended Millsaps College in Jackson, Mississippi where he earned a BA in 1939. He also received a BD from Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia and a Ph.D. in world religions from Yale University. In 1949, he married Araminta Harper and the couple had two daughters, Eugenia and Rebecca.

DeLamotte pastored churches in Connecticut and Tennessee before joining Paine College in Augusta, Georgia as a professor of Bible, Ethics and World Religions. He was active with Amnesty International, and promoted social justice and racial equality throughout his life. He wrote two novels under the pseudonym Gregory Wilson, as well as several plays and scholarly works. He was also a frequent contributor of letters to the editor of the *Augusta Chronicle*.

DeLamotte died in 2010.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Roy C. and Araminta H. DeLamotte from circa 1930-2010, including appointment books, correspondence, some financial records, subject and research files, photographs, printed material, and writings by DeLamotte. Writings include drafts and completed manuscripts of his plays and sermons. Writings also include published and unpublished works of fiction and nonfiction.
