#### **Biographical Note**

William P. Dowman lived in Perry, Georgia (Houston County) during the nineteenth century and was a Justice of the Peace.

**Scope and Content Note**

The collection contains a single record book belonging to William P. Dowman, with entries dated from 1833-1836. The book contains accounts of legal cases, inventory lists, lists of white and African American children in his district, lists of jurors, and lists of taxpayers (both whites and free blacks).
