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Collection Description

Administrative History

Emory University faculty began teaching at Emory's Atlanta campus in 1919 after being officially transferred from Oxford, Georgia following Emory College's reincorporation as Emory University. Since then, they have been involved in the administration of the University, its teaching, and its students. The faculty are organized by school, each represented by a corresponding Dean.

Scope and Content Note

Emory University Faculty records contain administrative materials related to the faculty's role in the governance of Emory University. Contained in the collection are by-laws and policy documents related to faculty rights and privileges, minutes from faculty meetings, and materials from committees regarding diverse issues like curricula, retirement, academic standards, and campaign planning. Materials pertaining to various awards and chairs throughout the University, as well as subject files, are included in the collection.
