Collection Description**Administrative History**

The Richard Ellmann Lectures in Modern Literature, now among the most prominent in North America, were established in honor of Richard Ellmann (1918-1987), who served Emory University as the first Robert W. Woodruff Professor from 1980 to 1987. The biographer of James Joyce and Oscar Wilde, Professor Ellmann enjoyed eminent domain among the interpreters of W.B. Yeats, Samuel Beckett, Henry James, T.S. Eliot, Wallace Stevens, and other modern authors.

The Richard Ellmann Lecturers from 1988 through 2008 include: Seamus Heaney, Denis Donoghue, Helen Vendler, Henry Louis Gates Jr., A.S. Byatt, David Lodge, Salman Rushdie, Mario Vargas Llosa, and Umberto Eco. Emory University professor of English Ronald Schuchard was involved in the administration of the series and the recruitment of lecturers.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of administrative files, correspondence, programs and handbills, lecture materials, a few photographs, and a small amount of biographical information about Richard Ellmann. Correspondence is chiefly of Ronald Schuchard with various modern authors relating to invitations to lecture. There are also audiovisual materials, mostly covering Seamus Heaney's 1988 lecture.
