**Abstract:** This collection contains the records of the peer-reviewed journal *Central European History*, edited by Emory University professor, Douglas A. Unfug, on behalf of the American Historical Association's Conference Group for Central European History. The collection consists of administrative materials, correspondence, and collected materials relating to editing of the journal, as well as materials related to the Conference Group itself.

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**Collection Description****Administrative History**

The *Central European History* journal was started in 1968 by the Conference Group for Central European History of the American Historical Association to provide scholars of German and Central European history a specialized academic journal following the cessation of publication of a similar journal in 1963. Emory University assumed financial and administrative responsibilities for the journal with Professor of History Douglas A. Unfug as editor. Dr. Unfug resigned from his editorial duties in 1990 and was succeeded by Kenneth Barkin of the University of California, Riverside.

**Scope and Content Note**

The collection contains mainly administrative materials and correspondence related to the editing of the journal from 1968 to 1990. Specifically, administrative materials include annual reports, budget and historical information, and documentation of copyright. Also contained in the collection are materials related to debate surrounding David Abraham's *The Collapse of the Weimar Republic*. A small series of material directly related to the Conference Group for Central European History includes meeting notes, correspondence, rosters, newsletters, and information about prizes for scholarship in the field. Selected materials related to the peer review process have been separated and restricted.

**Arrangement Note**

Organized into four series: (1) Administrative materials, (2) Correspondence, (3) Abraham/Feldman case, and (4) Conference Group on Central European History materials.
