### **Administrative History**

Founded in 1938, the University Center in Georgia was a cooperative initiative that included Agnes Scott College, the Atlanta Art Association, Columbia Theological Seminary, Emory University, the Georgia School of Technology, and the University of Georgia. The mission of the University Center in Georgia was to share resources between institutions, including projects and activities such as sharing library collections, inter-departmental faculty meetings, a visiting scholars program, an initiative to preserve materials about Georgia history, and fund raising for research grants.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of newsletters, correspondence, committee materials, promotional materials, fund raising materials, project files, and clippings related to the University Center in Georgia.
