James W. Wagner was born in Maryland in 1953. He graduated from the University of Delaware in 1975 with a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering. He received his master's degree in clinical engineering in 1978 from the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine and his doctorate in materials science and engineering also from Johns Hopkins in 1984. He was a professor at Johns Hopkins before moving to Case Western Reserve University where he was at various times dean, provost, and interim president. In 2003 Wagner was named president of Emory University.
