## **Collection Description**

### **Administrative History**

Shortly after Emory University was founded in 1837, the Phi Gamma Literary Society and Ignatius Few Literary Society held weekly public debates modeled after British Universities. In 1914, the Theology and Speech professor, Nolan A. Goodyear, started an intercollegiate debate team. After World War II caused a dissolution of the team, it was revived by an assistant professor, George A. Neely. Vice President (and Emory Alum) Alben W. Barkley allowed his name to be used in 1950, and a year later, the Barkley Forum hosted its first high school debate tournament as part of a growing interest in community service.

Glenn Pelham took the role as coach of the debate team in 1961 after his Cairo High School team won the 1959 Barkley Forum for High Schools and led the Barkley Forum as they became one of the most successful debating organizations in the country with over twenty national championship wins since 1967. The Barkley Forum also continued to host events including the Georgia Speaker of the Year and the Peachtree Debates.

In 1972, Glenn Pelham retired, and Melissa Maxcy Wade took the role of coach, expanding her role into Executive Director of Forensics and expanding the organization's community service programming. In addition to the Barkley Forum for High Schools (which was later named the Barkly Forum Summer Forensics Institute) and the Emory National Debate Institute, Wade developed the Urban Debate League (with support from the Open Society Institute) and the National Debate Program. In 1987, the Glenn Pelham Memorial Fund (later the Glenn Pelham Foundation) was created to manage the financial responsibilities of the Forum and its programs. Wade stepped down in 2015 but continued as a board member of the Glenn Pelham Foundation.

Ed Lee III – a former participant in the Atlanta Urban Debate League – took on the leadership of the Barkley Forum. Lee continued the competitive success of the team and engaged more student involvement on campus. In 2017, the name of the organization changed to The Barkley Forum for Debate, Deliberation, and Dialogue
