Collection Description

Biographical Note

Sally Fitzgerald (1917-2000) was a writer and editor of several volumes of Flannery O'Connor's letters and works. Sally and her husband, Robert Fitzgerald, met Flannery O'Connor in 1949, while O'Connor was finishing a fellowship at the Yaddo Community in New York. O'Connor then lived with the Fitzgeralds in Connecticut while writing her first novel, *Wise Blood*. In 1969, the Fitzgeralds co-edited *Mystery and Manners: Occasional Prose of Flannery O'Connor*. Sally then embarked on the project of compiling O'Connor's letters in the early 1970s and published *The Habit of Being: Letters of Flannery O'Connor* in 1979. Fitzgerald also edited the Library of America edition of *Flannery O'Connor: Collected Works*, released in 1988.

Publication Note

Selections of O'Connor's letters were originally published in 1979 in *The Habit of Being: Letters of Flannery O'Connor* edited by Sally Fitzgerald. Other letters edited by Sally Fitzgerald appear in *Collected Works by Flannery O'Connor*, which was published in 1988.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Sally Fitzgerald from circa 1930-2000. The collection reflects Fitzgerald's lifelong research and writing on American author Flannery O'Connor. The papers include correspondence, writings by Fitzgerald, printed material by and about Fitzgerald, photographs, writings by others, audiovisual material, and collected correspondence and writings relating to Flannery O'Connor.

The correspondence includes letters from friends and colleagues of Fitzgerald's; as well as numerous O'Connor friends, acquaintances and scholars. The writings series contains Fitzgerald's book-length works, articles, lectures, and interviews. The printed material series includes published works by and about Fitzgerald, the photograph series contains images of Fitzgerald and collected photos of O'Connor, and the audiovisual series includes two interviews of Fitzgerald. The series of collected correspondence and writings relating to Flannery O'Connor contains material that Fitzgerald accumulated over her years of research on O'Connor. The collection also includes writings by others which relate to O'Connor.

Scope and Content Note

The series contains correspondence to and from Sally Fitzgerald from 1964-2000. The correspondence contains letters of both a personal and professional nature. Fitzgerald maintained two sets of correspondence, one in alphabetical order by correspondent, the other in chronological order. The alphabetical correspondence includes letters from friends and colleagues; as well as numerous O'Connor friends, acquaintances and scholars. Correspondents include American women writers Elizabeth Bishop, Caroline Gordon, Flannery O'Connor, and Elizabeth Stevenson; O'Connor scholars Jean Cash, John Desmond, Sarah Gordon, Arthur Kennedy, Willard Pate, J.O. Tate, Karl-Heinz Westarp; O'Connor friends and family, Louise Hardeman Abbott, Louise Florencourt, Regina O'Connor, and Bill Sessions; and Fitzgerald friends Richard and Peggy Ellsburg, Dorothy Walker, and Marcella Comes Winslow.

Some of O'Connor's friends and acquaintances also sent Fitzgerald copies of their letters from O'Connor. There is a bracketed note in the container list when a file contains photocopies or originals of O'Connor correspondence. Additional O'Connor correspondence may be found in Series 6, Collected correspondence and writings relating to Flannery O'Connor.

The chronological correspondence contains letters of a more routine or general nature. The series also includes a small number of subject files relating to fellowships, conferences, or teaching.

Scope and Content Note

The writings of Sally Fitzgerald in this series span from 1969-2000, and are comprised of her research notebooks, lectures, essays, and book reviews. This series also contains typescripts of her book-length projects *Mystery and Manners*, *The Habit of Being* and the *Collected Works of Flannery O'Connor*. The material in this series is primarily made up of Fitzgerald's research and interest in her late friend Flannery O'Connor. Fitzgerald's writings on O'Connor serve to educate readers about her life, her works, and her Catholic beliefs. Fitzgerald's writing sheds particular light on the theological implications of O'Connor's work.

Fitzgerald's book-length works (Subseries 2.1) include the edited volumes *Mystery and Manners*, *The Habit of Being*, and the *Collected Works of Flannery O'Connor*. The subseries includes drafts and proofs, as well as correspondence and material relating to the publication process. This subseries also contains an introduction that Fitzgerald wrote for *Three by Flannery O'Connor* and drafts of chapters for Fitzgerald's unfinished biography of Flannery O'Connor, *The Mansions of the South*.

The other writings subseries (Subseries 2.2) features Fitzgerald's short works, including lectures, essays, and a few book reviews. Several of the lecture files include Fitzgerald's correspondence with the inviting institution. This series is also made up of Fitzgerald's book reviews, research notes on O'Connor, and files of quotations.

The notebook subseries (Subseries 2.3) is comprised of more than fifty notebooks that Fitzgerald kept from 1978 through the mid-1990s. She used many of these notebooks to keep track of her research on O'Connor, while others contain drafts of the talks and essays she composed.

Scope and Content Note

The book-length works subseries, spanning from 1969-1990, includes material related to the three published volumes of Flannery O'Connor's writings that Fitzgerald edited, in addition to Fitzgerald's unpublished biography of O'Connor. The first edited volume, *Mystery and Manners: Occasional Prose* (1969), contains essays, speeches, and lectures by O'Connor. The subseries contains drafts edited by Fitzgerald for publication in the volume and other material relating to the publication process. In addition, there are copies of O'Connor's original writings that Fitzgerald considered for inclusion in the volume; these writings are arranged alphabetically under O'Connor's name.

Material pertaining to *The Habit of Being: Letters of Flannery O'Connor* (1979), primarily consists of drafts of O'Connor's letters that Fitzgerald compiled for publication in the volume, as well as drafts of the introduction written by Fitzgerald. For the *Collected Works of Flannery O'Connor* (1988), which Fitzgerald often refers to as the Library of America or LOA edition, Fitzgerald compiled O'Connor's short prose, book-length fiction, letters, and essays. The subseries contains material pertaining to the editorial process for *Collected Works*, including notes about selecting letters by O'Connor for the volume and lists of edits of the letters. Drafts of letters that are included with *The Habit of Being* may also have been used by Fitzgerald in the process of re-editing the letters for *Collected Works*. Fitzgerald also wrote a chronology of O'Connor's life for inclusion in *Collected Works*. The subseries contains typescript and manuscript drafts of this chronology. Undated drafts are arranged arbitrarily, followed by dated drafts arranged in chronological order. The subseries also contains proofs of *Collected Works* as well as Fitzgerald's correspondence with the publisher. In addition to editing these three published volumes of O'Connor's writings, Fitzgerald also wrote the introduction for *Three by Flannery O'Connor*; drafts of this introduction can also be found in the subseries.

The subseries also contains fragments of Fitzgerald's unfinished biography of Flannery O'Connor, which she tentatively titled *The Mansions of the South*. The unpublished work includes the chapter "Good Country Girl" as well as "The Stout Stake." Also included is a proposed table of contents, which points to several of Fitzgerald's lectures, found in Subseries 2.2, Other writings, as the basis for the other chapters.

Scope and Content Note

The other writings subseries is comprised of lectures, articles/essays, book reviews, and miscellaneous research notes from circa 1978-2000. Much of this subseries is made up of the talks Fitzgerald gave on Flannery O'Connor for more than two decades. Fitzgerald often recycled her material, polishing her ideas with each presentation. The talks and essays enlighten readers about subjects ranging from O'Connor's personal life to the symbolism in her writing. The lectures entitled "Other People's Mail" and "Flannery O'Connor's Letters" describe the difficulties Fitzgerald faced collecting and publishing O'Connor's letters. The essay "A Moving Target" discusses the film version of O'Connor's novel *Wise Blood*, which two of Sally's sons produced and wrote. The series also contains two interviews of Fitzgerald; one by Liz Evans in circa 1994 and the other by Susan Howe at Brigham Young University in 1995.

Scope and Content Note

The series contains materials by or about Flannery O'Connor that were collected by Fitzgerald in the course of her research on O'Connor. The materials include correspondence, both original and photocopies, between O'Connor and her circle of friends including Caroline Gordon, Betty Hester, Lee Maryat, and Janet McKane. Additional copies of O'Connor correspondence which was sent to Fitzgerald may be found in Series 1, Correspondence - the presence of such correspondence is noted in the container list for that series.

In addition, the series contains some of O'Connor's works, typescripts and published, that either were sent to Fitzgerald directly by O'Connor or collected by Fitzgerald in the course of her research. The O'Connor typescripts include her short stories "The Enduring Chill," "Everything that Rises Must Converge," "A Good Man is Hard to Find," "The King of the Birds," "Parker's Back," "A View of the Woods," and "Judgment Day." A complete typescript of O'Connor's second novel, *The Violent Bear It Away* (1960) is also included. The remainder of the printed materials consists of published works about O'Connor including articles and essays, book reviews, and newspaper clippings. The series also contains copies of several books owned by Fitzgerald either by or about O'Connor which are heavily annotated by Fitzgerald.
