**Collection Description****Biographical Note**

Hal Gulliver was an editor and columnist for the *Atlanta Constitution* (Georgia) from circa 1970-1982, with a focus on the Georgia political scene and Jimmy Carter's presidential campaign. His book, *The Southern Strategy* (1971), co-authored with Reg Murphy, discusses Jimmy Carter's 1970 gubernatorial campaign, as well as Richard Nixon's presidential campaign. Gulliver also wrote a mystery novel, *Kill with Style* (1974), and published a compilation of essays from his time at the *Atlanta Constitution*, titled *A Friendly Tongue* (1984).

**Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of the papers of journalist Hal Gulliver from 1960-1982 and contains subject files and the subject files include correspondence with notable Georgians relating to the *Atlanta Constitution* (Georgia), news clippings, and Jimmy Carter campaign travel notes. These travel notes contain news clippings relating to campaign stops and election updates. There are also materials related to Gulliver's mystery novel, *Kill with Style* (1974), as well as personal correspondence (1975-1982).
