Biographical Note

Marvin H. Harper, alumnus of Emory University, was a Methodist missionary to India (ca. 1927-1957) and taught at the Leonard Theological College in Jubbulpore, India.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of papers of Marvin Henry Harper from 1921-1957. The papers include correspondence, personal writings, and printed material (1921-1926) relating to volunteer work, mainly through the Student Volunteer Movement for Foreign Missions during his years at Emory University; and correspondence (1927-1956) from Harper and his wife, Emmie Flicklen Harper, to family, friends, and church sponsors, written while serving as missionaries with the Methodist Episcopal Church at the Leonard Theological College in Jubbulpore, India. The papers also include Harper's personal writings; reports of Leonard Theological College (1932-1957); and printed materials consisting of programs, pamphlets, and magazine and newspaper articles. The collection reflects living conditions and daily life of the Indian people and of a Christian missionary community in India during the mid-twentieth century.
