Collection Description**Biographical Note**

Rita Ann Higgins was born in Galway, Ireland, in 1955. She married Christopher Higgins in 1973, and the couple have two daughters, Jennifer and Heather. In 1977, she contracted tuberculosis and was confined to a sanitarium during which she began to write poetry. Higgins has published ten volumes of poetry: *Goddess on the Mervue Bus* (1986), *Witch in the Bushes* (1988), *Goddess and Witch* (1990), *Philomena's Revenge* (1992), *Higher Purchase* (1996), *Sunny Side Plucked* (1996), *An Awful Racket* (2001), *Throw in the Vowels: New & Selected Poems* (2005), *Ireland Is Changing Mother* (2011), and *Tongulish* (2016). She also published an autobiographical volume of essays and poetry in 2010, *Hurting God*, which caused some controversy in her family. After reading an advance copy, Higgins' brother Joe threatened to sue if an essay about him and their mother was not changed. Higgins removed the offending passages, the book was published in its edited form, and the publisher, Salmon Poetry, was forced to pulp nearly 900 copies of the original printing. Higgins has written numerous stage plays and screenplays. She was writer in residence for Galway County (1987); the National University of Ireland, Galway (1994-1995); and Offaly County Council (1998-1999). She was named Green Honors Professor at Texas Christian University (Fort Worth, Texas) in October 2000 and has been an honorary fellow of Hong Kong Baptist University since 2006. She regularly teaches poetry writing workshops and is a member of Aosdána, an Irish association of artists. While writer in residence at the National University of Ireland, Galway, Higgins received two diplomas, one in the Irish Language and one in Women's Studies. She has been outspoken on political issues in Ireland such as women's rights and the treatment of Traveller communities.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Rita Ann Higgins from 1968-2011 and includes correspondence, personal papers, writings, printed material, and audiovisual material. Correspondence is both personal and professional and contains letters from Neil Astley, Paul Durcan, Gráinne Healy, Anne Kennedy, Ted McNulty, Vivienne Plumb, Alison Leslie Gold, and Eva Bourke, as well as letters regarding her participation in Aosdána and the Cúirt literary festival. There are also numerous letters from Higgins' husband, Christopher (Christy), her daughters, Heather and Jennifer, and her niece, Carmel. Personal papers contain financial records, photographs, travel documents, academic records, journals, day planners, planning calendars, and materials documenting Higgins' political activities. Writings consist of poetry, prose, scripts, and notes and notebooks by Higgins, as well as poetry and prose by writers such as Neil Astley, Eva Bourke, Anne Kennedy, Joan McBreen, Patsy Murphy, Julia Roddy, and Moya Roddy. Printed material includes fliers, programs, brochures, posters, and other

promotional material relating to Higgins' work and interests such as health and wellness and Irish politics. Audiovisual material contains sound and video recordings of interviews with and poetry readings by Rita Ann Higgins, as well as readings by other poets and recordings relating to Irish news and politics.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of Rita Ann Higgins' correspondence from 1977-2011. Letters are both personal and professional in nature and document Higgins' relationships with friends, family, and colleagues. There are many letters regarding publication of her poetry, particularly from editor Neil Astley at Bloodaxe Books and agent Gráinne Healy, as well as letters from professional organizations such as Aosdána and literary festivals such as Cúirt. Other professional letters are from colleges and universities inviting her to speak on their campus. There are also numerous letters from Higgins' husband, Christopher (Christy), her daughters, Heather and Jennifer, and her sister, Carmel, as well as friends Anne Kennedy, Paul Durcan, Ted McNulty, Vivienne Plumb, Alison Leslie Gold, and Eva Bourke. Correspondence from August 2004 contains sympathy cards and notes sent to Higgins following the murder of her brother, Anthony, in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. Many letters in this series are written in Gaelic.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of the personal papers of Rita Ann Higgins from 1968-2013 and includes financial records, photographs, travel documents, academic records, journals, day planners, planning calendars, and materials documenting Higgins' political activities with the Galway Against Censorship Group, the Irish Writers Union, and the Cultural Relations Committee of Ireland among others. The series also contains writing awards and university application materials, contracts, and a small number of subject files. Academic records include materials documenting Higgins' tenure as writer in residence at the National University of Ireland, Galway (1994-1995), her diploma in Women's Studies from the National University of Ireland (formerly University College), Galway (1994-1996), and her participation in writing courses and Irish and Spanish language courses. Course notes and workshop materials may include poems used by Higgins for instruction purposes.

The series also documents Higgins' membership in Aosdána, the honorary association of artists supported by the Arts Council of Ireland, and activities relating to the leadership and membership nomination processes of the group. There are also files documenting Higgins' participation in the Galway Arts Center's annual Cúirt International Festival of Literature, her role as judge for the International Dublin Literary Award (IMPAC), and her participation in and travel to literary events, scholarly conferences, and creative workshops, such as the International Writers Workshop hosted by the Hong Kong Baptist University. Photographs in this series are primarily comprised of family and travel photographs and photographs of Higgins with friends and literary figures such as Eva Bourke and Anne Kennedy. There are also portraits of Higgins taken by the poet Anne Kennedy, and photographs of Anthony Higgins' funeral in 2004.

The series consists of writings by Rita Ann Higgins and others from 1970-2011. Writings by Higgins include poetry, scripts, prose, and notes and notebooks. Poetry by Higgins contains drafts of individual poems as well as proofs and book covers of Higgin's collections, *Goddess on the Mervue Bus* (1986), *Witch in the Bushes* (1988), *Philomena's Revenge* (1993), *Sunny Side Plucked* (1997), *Higher Purchase* (1997), *An Awful Racket* (2001), *Throw in the Vowels* (2005), *Hurting God* (2010), *Ireland is Changing Mother* (2011), and *Tongulish* (2016). Poetry also contains drafts of uncollected and unpublished poems, as well as some unidentified collections. Scripts contain typescripts of Higgins' stage plays, *Face Licker Come Home* (1991), *God of the Hatch Man* (1992), *Down All the Roundabouts* (1999), *The Empty Frame* (2008), and *The Plastic Bag* (2008), and her screenplay *The Big Break* (2004). Prose consists of drafts of essays, interviews conducted by Higgins and interviews of Higgins, reviews by Higgins, and speeches. Many writings by Higgins, including both poetry and prose, are written in Gaelic. Writings by others includes poetry and prose by Neil Astley, Eva Bourke, Edward Boyne, Anne Kennedy, Joan McBreen, Patsy Murphy, Julia Roddy, and Moya Roddy, as well as poetry by students of workshops taught by Higgins and research papers about Higgins and her poetry.

Scope and Content Note

The subseries consists of poetry written by Rita Ann Higgins from 1986-2011 and collected in her volumes *Goddess on the Mervue Bus* (1986), *Witch in the Bushes* (1988), *Philomena's Revenge* (1993), *Higher Purchase* (1997), *An Awful Racket* (2001), *Throw in the Vowels* (2005), *Hurting God* (2010), *Ireland is Changing Mother* (2011), and *Tongulish* (2016). *Hurting God* is an autobiographical work that includes both prose and poetry. It was controversial in the Higgins family. After reading an advance copy, Higgins' brother Joe threatened to sue over the content of an essay about him and their mother. Higgins removed the offending passages, the book was republished in its edited form, and nearly 900 copies of the original printing were destroyed. Themes in Higgins poetry include Women's rights, Irish politics, poverty, and personal experiences such as the death of her brother Tony, her struggle with tuberculosis, and her international travels. The subseries also contains front matter, proofs, and book covers for the volumes, though the only material in the series pertaining to *Sunny Side Plucked* (1997) are book covers. All drafts of poems are included with the collection in which they were first published. There are additional unidentified, unpublished collections that contain poems arranged together by Higgins. The container list includes notes to indicate when drafts of multiple poems appear together on a page.

Arrangement Note

Collections are arranged in chronological order by date of publication. Individual poem drafts are arranged in alphabetical order by poem title. Proofs, front matter, and book covers are arranged in alphabetical order after the poem drafts.

Processing Note

The collections in this subseries are arranged according to publication date, including the poems in the collection published in Higgins' 2016 volume *Tongulish*. However, all of the drafts in this subseries were written prior to 2011 when the Rose Library acquired the Higgins papers.

The subseries consists of other writings by Higgins from 1982-2010 and includes scripts, prose, and notes and notebooks. Scripts contain typescripts of Higgins' stage plays, *Face Licker Come Home* (1991); *God of the Hatch Man* (1992); *Down All the Roundabouts* (1999); *The Empty Frame* (2008), inspired by Athlone writer Hanna Greally; and *The Plastic Bag* (2008). The subseries also contains drafts of Higgins' screenplay, *The Big Break* (2004). *Face Licker Come Home* was produced in 1991 by Punchbag Theatre Company (Galway, Ireland) and *God of the Hatchman* was produced by the same company in 1993. Scripts also include unpublished typescripts and unidentified works. Prose consists of drafts of essays, school papers, interviews conducted by Higgins and interviews of Higgins, reviews of other people's work written by Higgins, and speeches. Some prose is written in Gaelic. School papers include drafts of unpublished poems and essays on Women's Studies that focus on feminism, nationalism, and women's writing. Prose also contains reviews by Higgins of poetry by Carol Ann Duffy and Tomas Venclova, photography by Fergus Bourke, and reviews of poetry anthologies. Notebooks contain drafts of published and unpublished poetry, scripts, and essays.

Scope and Content Note

The series consists of audiovisual materials about and collected by Rita Ann Higgins from 1974-2010. Audiovisual material about Rita Ann Higgins includes television and radio interviews on the BBC and Radio Telefís Eireann/RTE, including the broadcast copy of the Radio Telefís Eireann/RTE "Would You Believe" feature on Higgins in 2002. There is also a recording of her appearance in Poetry Ireland's video series, "The Poets' Chair" (2008), the International Writers' Symposium at Hong Kong Baptist University (2006), and recordings of Higgins reading early drafts of *Ireland is Changing Mother* and *Throw in the Vowels*. Additional items of interest include an audio recording of Higgins' conversation with the Dalarna University Centre for Irish Studies in Sweden (True to the Subversive) and a video recording of a tribute to the Irish politician and activist, Peadar O'Donnell, at the University College in 1986. Materials collected by Higgins include recordings about the Galway Traveller Movement, the lawsuit of journalist Bríd Cummins against Galway City Council, readings by poets Fred Bazler and Jack Mitchell, audio recordings of radio broadcasts on poetry and Irish politics, an unidentified recording of Dylan Thomas' radio drama, "Under Milk Wood," and commercial recordings by 57 Productions, including "Teeth" by Jackie Kay and "Hearsay: Performance Poems Plus" featuring poets including Higgins. There is also footage from theatre performances such as "My Roof is Not My Home" by the Galway Film and Video Coop and "Hatch 22" by the Galway Unemployed Community Arts Group.
