Grace Hightower (1918-), was born in Brundidge, Alabama. She worked as a librarian and served on the Georgia Department of Education's school library unit from 1948-1976.

The collection consists of the papers of Grace Hightower from 1936-1976. The papers also include speeches, notes and drafts of her published work on school library service, a notebook of collected materials regarding various authors, and miscellaneous articles, pamphlets, reports, pictures, and awards.
