Collection Description

Biographical Note

Henry Thompson Malone, educator, was born July 4, 1916, in Albany, Georgia, and died in October, 1977. He was a graduate of Emory University (M.A., Ph.D.) and taught in high schools in South Carolina and Georgia. Malone was with Georgia State University for twenty-five years as a professor (1952-1961), as an assistant dean of arts and sciences (1952-1958), as director of development (1958-), as director of alumni (1961-), and as dean of the School of General Studies (1970-1977). Among other achievements, Malone served on the Georgia Historical Commission (1963-1973); was the author of two books; and was Georgia District Governor of Kiwanis as well as president of the Georgia Kiwanis Foundation.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Henry Thompson Malone from 1933-1977. The papers include personal and family documents, photographs, a card file, subject files, notes, correspondences, clippings, printed material, and memorabilia. Materials relate to Malone's family life and career. Included are speeches and writings, information on Emory University, Georgia State University, the Kiwanis, and on his research on Cherokee Indians.
