Processing

Unprocessed collection

Born digital materials processed, arranged, and described by Brenna Edwards, 2020. Born digital materials include files taken from 55 5.25" floppy disks, 110 3.5" floppy disks, 1 Zip disk, and 1 optical disc.

Forensic disk images were created from the floppy disks using Kryoflux and from the zip disk and optical disc using GuyMager. Individual files were extracted using FTK Imager and scanned for viruses using McAfee's anti-virus software; none were found. Duplicate and system files have been removed, and files were scanned for personally identifiable information; none were found. Text-based files were migrated to PDF using Adobe Acrobat and image files were migrated to JPG using Microsoft Paint. File dates have been changed from the original creation date. Access copies retain original folder titles and file names.

Collection Description**Biographical Note**

Henry H. and Ella Pearson Mitchell are African American professors and Baptist ministers from Atlanta, Georgia. Henry Mitchell was born in Columbus, Ohio in 1919. He earned a Bachelor of Arts from Lincoln University in Pennsylvania, a Master of Divinity from Union Theological Seminary in New York, an Master of Art. from California State University at Fresno, and a Doctor of Theology from the school of Theology at Claremont. He was also ordained as a minister in the Baptist church in 1944. His wife, Ella Mitchell, is also an ordained minister and founded the Ecumenical Center for Black Church Studies in Los Angeles, California.

Scope and Content Note

The collection contains the papers of Henry H. and Ella Pearson Mitchell from 1981-2002. The papers include sound recordings and video recordings of sermons, course syllabi and corresponding sound recordings of classes taught by Henry H. Mitchell, slides from lectures and presentations, dissertation notes and drafts, book manuscripts, family photographs, subject and research files, awards, and correspondence. Born digital materials include correspondence, sermons, and writings.
