Biographical Note

Jack Henry Parks (1918-) was a newspaper editor in Dahlonega, Georgia. In 1949, he bought the *Dahlonega Nugget*, which he owned and edited for most of his career.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Jack Henry Parks circa 1945-1970. The papers include letters and photographs. Letters consist mainly of Parks' correspondence with U.S. Senator Richard B. Russell, and discuss matters of patronage (1960-1970). Photographs include documentation of conditions in Okinawa during World War II (circa 1945), as well as pictures of Parks, Richard B. Russell, and Ralph McGill.
