Processing

Unprocessed collection.

Born digital materials processed, arranged, and described by Brenna Edwards, 2020. Born digital materials include files taken from a file transfer.

Forensic disk images were created from the file transfer using CygWin. Individual files were extracted using FTK Imager and scanned for viruses using McAfee's anti-virus software; none were found. Duplicate and system files have been removed, and files were scanned for personally identifiable information; none were found. Text-based files were migrated to PDF using Adobe Acrobat and image files were migrated to JPG using Microsoft Paint. File dates have been changed from the original creation date. Access copies retain original folder titles and file names.

Collection Description**Biographical Note**

Robert L. (Robb) Pitts (circa 1947-) is an Atlanta, Georgia, politician and businessman. He served on the Atlanta City Council for 20 years and was elected president of that body in 1997. He has been a member of the Fulton County Board of Commissioners since 2002. As commissioner, he is a vocal proponent of bringing casino gambling to Fulton County.

Scope and Content Note

The collection consists of the papers of Robert L. (Robb) Pitts from circa 1947-2014 including subject files, scrapbooks, Fulton County Board of Commissioners records, photographs, printed material, and audiovisual material. The papers primarily document Pitts' political career and work with Fulton County Board of Commissioners and Atlanta City Council. Born digital materials include correspondence, Fulton County Board of Commissioners records, photographs, and subject files.
