Paul L. Sitton, federal employee, was born in Emory (now part of Atlanta), Georgia, and died in 1987. He was the brother of Pulitzer-Prize winning journalist Claude F. Sitton, a graduate of Emory University (1948), and an administrator for the United States Department of Transportation until his death.

**Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of the papers of Paul L. Sitton which documents his career as a transportation administrator with the federal government. The papers include correspondence, reports, and office files.
