### **Processing**

Arranged and described at the folder level by Sarah Quigley, Haylee Harrell, and Ingrid Meintjes, 2016. Born digital material processed by Sarah Quigley and Dorothy Waugh, September 2016. The born digital files are taken from 3.5" floppy disks and compact discs. Images of the floppy disks were created using FTK Imager and images of the compact discs were made using Guymager. Master copies of these images were ingested into a Fedora instance at Emory University for long-term preservation. Individual files were extracted from the disk images using FTK Imager and were scanned for viruses using McAfee's anti-virus software. The extracted files consisted of Microsoft Word documents, Microsoft Power Point presentations, PDFs, MP3 files, and Jpeg images. The Microsoft Word files were migrated to PDF for access and use copies were made of the other files in their original format. Files are arranged by record type and according to the series structure of the collection.

## **Collection Description**

### **Biographical Note**

John Stone (1936-2008) was born in Jackson, Mississippi. Stone received his B.A. from Millsaps College (Jackson, Mississippi) in 1958 and his M.D. from Washington University (St. Louis, Missouri) in 1962. After completing his residency in medicine and cardiology at the University of Rochester (New York), Stone accepted a fellowship in cardiology at Emory University (Atlanta, Georgia) in 1969. In addition to teaching at Emory, Stone also worked at Grady Memorial Hospital from 1974-1985, where he founded and directed the hospital's emergency medicine residency program. As a faculty member at the Emory University School of Medicine, Stone created one of the first medical school courses on literature and medicine. He also served as associate dean and director of admissions.

Stone published his first book of poetry, *The Smell of Matches*, in 1972. Other poetry volumes followed, including *In All This Rain* (1980), *Renaming the Streets* (1985), *Where Water Begins: New Poems and Prose* (1998), and *Music from Apartment 8* (2004). He also published two books of essays on medicine, *In the Country of Hearts: Journeys in the Art of Medicine* (1990) and *On Doctoring: Stories, Poems, Essays* (1991), for which he was co-editor. *On Doctoring*

was popular amongst medical educators and was frequently handed out to new medical school students at annual white coat ceremonies. His poetry and prose often explored the connections between medicine and literature.

Stone married Sarah Lucretia "Lu" Crymes in 1960. The couple had two sons, Jim Stone and John Stone, both doctors. Lu Stone died unexpectedly in 1991, which heavily influenced both his poetry and prose afterward. Stone's second wife, Mae Nelson Stone, was a close friend and long-time colleague at Emory University. John Stone died on November 6, 2008 in Atlanta, Georgia.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of the papers of John Stone from 1902-2008. It includes correspondence, writings, subject files, photographs, artwork, printed material, audiovisual material, and born digital material documenting Stone's career as a cardiologist, educator, and prolific poet and essayist. Correspondence contains both personal and professional letters between Stone and his publishers; President Jimmy Carter; editor Delese Wear; poets Miller Williams and Janice Moore; poet/teacher Sister Bernetta Quinn; and colleagues Melvin J. Konner and Kenneth Sharlin. Correspondence also includes letters from Stone's family and fans. Writings are comprised of poetry, prose, speeches, and notes by Stone. Poetry contains drafts of individual poems as well as typescripts, editorial correspondence, proofs, and other documents relating to the publication of Stone's collections *The Smell of Matches* (1972), *In All This Rain* (1980), *Renaming the Streets* (1985), *Where Water Begins* (1998), and *Music from Apartment 8* (2004).

Prose consists of drafts of articles, book chapters, and essays, and also includes typescripts, editorial correspondence, proofs, and other documents relating to the publication of Stone's collections *In the Country of Hearts: Journeys in the Art of Medicine* (1990) and *On Doctoring: Stories, Poems, Essays* (1991). Articles, book chapters, and essays consist of medical and scientific works, including collaborations with Dr. J. Willis Hurst, in addition to works about literature and medicine, medicine and the humanities, and physician writers. Speech files contain planning documents such as correspondence with host institutions and travel itineraries, copies of the speech Stone gave, and promotional material for the event. Notes and notebooks contain poem drafts, phone numbers and addresses, and other personal notes.

Subject files document Stone's professional career and relationships with physicians, physician writers, poets, and editors. Files may contain teaching materials, medical research, correspondence between Stone and others, printed material about others, and poems and prose by others including Melvin J. Konner, Emory Professor of Anthropology; Sally Wolff-King, Emory Professor of Medicine; and James Harvey Young, Emory Professor of American Social History. Photographs include both candid and professional photos of Stone, photographs of Stone as a child and with his family, and photographs of events. There is also professional photography by David Alansley (?) and Mario DiGirolamo. Artwork is primarily comprised of prints, caricatures, portraits, and landscapes and includes works by Eleazar Albin and Charles Demouth.

Printed material contains reprints of published articles by Stone as well as published articles, interviews, reviews, and promotional material about Stone. Other printed material includes magazines, newspaper clippings, medical and art journals, and promotional materials for Emory University events. Audiovisual material contains sound and video recordings of John Stone such as readings, speeches, and interviews. Recordings of others include poetry readings from John Ciardi and Williams Carlos Williams, among other events. The video recordings also contain

informational medical tapes about anatomy, emergency medical services, and the integration of the humanities with medicine. Born digital material consist of poem drafts, speeches, and photographs and date primarily from 2003-2006.

**Scope and Content Note**

The series consists of the correspondence of John Stone from 1941-2008. It contains professional letters between Stone and his publishers and editors such as Rutgers University Press, The American Scholar, Southern Review, Briarcliff Press, Writers Digest Books, and The New York Times. These letters may contain information about publicity events, readings, and approval or denial of new poems. The series also includes personal correspondence with Jimmy Carter, editor Delese Wear, poets Miller Williams and Janice Moore, poet/teacher Sister Bernetta Quinn, and colleagues Melvin J. Konner and Kenneth Sharlin. These letters may contain poetry by the individual, photographs of the individual and/or their families, and also invitations to personal and professional events such as holiday celebrations and writing conferences. Personal correspondence also contains letters from Stone's family, which often detail family vacations and experiences at medical school.

**Scope and Content Note**

The series consists of writings by John Stone from circa 1954-2008. It includes poetry, prose, speeches, and notes and notebooks. Poetry contains drafts of individual poems as well as typescripts, editorial correspondence, proofs, and other documents relating to the publication of Stone's collections *The Smell of Matches* (1972), *In All This Rain* (1980), *Renaming the Streets* (1985), *Where Water Begins* (1998), and *Music from Apartment 8* (2004). Prose consists of drafts of articles, book chapters, and essays, and also includes typescripts, editorial correspondence, proofs, and other documents relating to the publication of Stone's collections *In the Country of Hearts: Journeys in the Art of Medicine* (1990) and *On Doctoring: Stories, Poems, Essays* (1991). Articles, book chapters, and essays contain medical and scientific works in addition to works about literature and medicine, medicine and the humanities, and physician writers. In writing articles and book chapters about medical subjects, Stone often collaborated with J. Willis Hurst. *On Doctoring* was a popular book among medical educators and was often given to new medical school students at annual white coat ceremonies.

Speech files contain planning documents such as correspondence with host institutions and travel itineraries, copies of the speech Stone gave, and promotional material for the event. Not all files include the speech text. Notes and notebooks contain poem drafts, phone numbers and addresses, and other personal notes.

#### Scope and Content Note

The subseries consists of poetry written by John Stone from circa 1954-2004 and includes drafts of individual poems as well as material relating to the publication of several collections of poems. Poem drafts include both manuscript and typescript versions of works. Though versions are frequently unlabeled and are arranged in no particular order, the earliest drafts are often hand-written on 3 x 5 index cards and proceed through additional manuscript versions to final typescripts. Common themes in Stone's poetry are medicine and healthcare, childhood, parenthood, and nature. One poem, "The Spirits of this Lawn," was written in commemoration of Emory University President James Wagner's inauguration in 2004. Poems are undated unless otherwise noted. The subseries also includes translations by Stone of two poems by Rainer Maria Rilke. Collections include typescripts, proofs, publisher correspondence, and other documents relating to the publication of *The Smell of Matches* (1972), *In All This Rain* (1980), *Renaming the Streets* (1985), *Where Water Begins* (1998), and *Music from Apartment 8* (2004). There are also unpublished collections present in the subseries.

#### Arrangement Note

Arranged into three sections: poem drafts, translations, and collections. Poem drafts and translations are arranged in alphabetical order by poem title. Poems with relatively few drafts can be found together in folders according to the first letter of their title. Poems with numerous drafts have been foldered individually. Collections are arranged in alphabetical order by collection title.

The subseries consists of prose by John Stone from 1958-2004 and includes articles, book chapters, and essays, as well as collections of essays and other book-length works edited or written by Stone. Articles, book chapters, and essays contain medical and scientific works in addition to works about literature and medicine, medicine and the humanities, and physician writers. In writing articles and book chapters about medical subjects, Stone often collaborated with J. Willis Hurst, prominent cardiologist and former Chairman of the Emory University Department of Medicine. Most files include multiple drafts of the publication as well as correspondence with the publisher; some files also include research material on the topic (see Series 3: Subject files for additional research material). Stone published a series of articles in *The New York Times Magazine* from 1988-1989 that he published again later, sometimes under new titles, in *In the Country of Hearts: Journeys in the Art of Medicine*.

Collections and other book-length works primarily contain typescripts, correspondence, proofs, and other documents relating to the publication of *In the Country of Hearts: Journeys in the Art of Medicine* (1990) and *On Doctoring: Stories, Poems, Essays* (1991). *On Doctoring* was a popular book among medical educators and was often given to new medical school students at annual white coat ceremonies. The subseries includes documentation from all three editions of *On Doctoring*, showing changes from version to version. There are additional materials relating to an unpublished work, *The Human Encounter in Medicine*.

The subseries consists of speeches, lectures, and poetry readings given by John Stone from 1969-2008. Files contain planning documents such as correspondence with host institutions and travel itineraries, copies of the speech Stone gave, and promotional material for the event. Not all files include the speech text. Stone often combined multiple speaking engagements in one trip and some files may overlap in content. He most often spoke at medical school commencements and white coat ceremonies and events exploring the role of the humanities in medicine. He frequently gave the same speeches at similar events, though he would tweak and edit the content for each engagement. The subseries also includes files entitled "prototypical readings," which contain outlines for speeches and poetry readings and well as some complete speech texts. These files may contain outlines and notes for engagements that do not have individual planning files elsewhere in the subseries.

**Scope and Content Note**

The series consists of subject files documenting Stone's professional career and relationships with physicians, physician writers, poets, and editors. Files may contain correspondence between Stone and others, printed material about others, and poems and prose by others including Delese Wear, co-editor of *On Doctoring: Stories, Poems, Essays*; the poet Miller Williams; author/teacher Mildred Greear; poet Janice Moore (Professor of English at Young Harris College); Melvin J. Konner, Emory Professor of Anthropology; Sally Wolff-King, Emory Professor of Medicine; and James Harvey Young, Emory Professor of American Social History. The series also includes personal letters and poetry by President Jimmy Carter.

The series also contains Stone's teaching materials from Emory University School of Medicine and the Emory University British Summer Abroad Program at Oxford College. Teaching materials include syllabi and readings for courses in bioethics, human values and medicine, and literature and medicine. Other subject files reflect Stone's personal or professional interest in topics such as AIDS, cardiology, adolescent health, and suicide.

Subject files also include materials relating to Stone's involvement with the *Journal of Literature and Medicine* as well as his conference, committee, and workshop participation. There are files that chronicle his attendance at and service to the Bread Loaf Writers Conference (1968-1973), Emory University's Middle East Travel Seminar (1998 and 2005), the International Arts and Medicine Association Conference, and the Committee on Cultural and Social Affairs at the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions.
